



MESSAGE FROM ALISON WRAGG LEADING THE PRAYERS FOR THE SUNDAY MORNING SERVICE - if you are joining on Zoom or Facebook you may like to have ready with you a small piece of tin foil about the size of your hand for use during the prayers. People in church will be given a piece of tin foil to use.

CHURCH BUILDING - NEW RISK ASSESSMENT FOR CHURCH - now that we are in stage 4 of the recovery plan, we have revised our guidelines for the church. The main difference is that we have removed social distancing in the middle of the church (side aisles are still socially distanced), and masks are not compulsory. Our guidance is that you wear a mask whilst moving around in church and singing. Sanitiser will be available, and Communion will take place without wine. We hope to review these guidelines again in September before the choirs return fully. We understand that some people are still shielding and may not feel ready to return to the church building and we will continue to broadcast on ZOOM and Facebook live each week for the morning service. We have now reverted to our regular service pattern - please see the church website.

<u>JOINING WORSHIP FROM HOME</u> – The Sunday morning service will continue to be in Church, on Zoom and Facebook live until further notice.

Our Sunday evening services are open to all in Church and during August we will cease broadcasting these services due to staffing. We will advise in September about broadcasting evening services.
